Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## **SCRIPTURE**

Revelation 21:1-5,22-27; 22:1-5

## SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we'll see what will happen to God's creation and God's people when Jesus returns. Here are the key takeaways:

- The Lord is coming again to renew His creation (Revelation 21:1-5).
- The Lord is coming again to reveal His glory (Revelation 21:22-27).
- The Lord is coming again to reside with His people (Revelation 22:1-5).

## **CONVERSATION QUESTIONS**

- Jot down some of the attributes of God you see in Revelation 21:4. Discuss which of these stands out to each family member and why.
- What are you most looking forward to based on the description of the new city God will create?
- How can these passages encourage us when we struggle and bring us joy when we think about the future? Get specific!

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

Ask each person to find materials to build a small model house with; no one can use the same materials. Some ideas include playing cards, books, boxes, paper and tape, and so on. Get creative! Set a time limit and then talk about the houses you made. While you took objects that were already there and made something new with them, you didn't create any of those items. We can make something new or better out of what's here, but we can't create out of nothing. Only God can make new things and make old things completely new.
